General Campus Information

- **Photo Identification Cards**

All students are encouraged to obtain and carry a PVCC Photo ID Card while on campus. You may obtain your Photo ID card at the College Safety Office (KSC-126). This card is free and is also used in the Library, Fitness Center, Learning Support Center and Computer Labs. A \$5.00 fee is charged to replace lost cards.

- **Parking Decals**

All students who drive motor vehicles on the PVCC campus are required to register the vehicle with the College Safety Office (KSC-126). Parking stickers are free. You must know your vehicle license number to obtain a parking decal.

- **College Safety Issues**

Athletic Information

- **Scholarships**

Arizona residents are eligible for talent scholarships. MCCCCD policy prohibits scholarship awards to out-of-state students. Students must be academically eligible to compete in that semester and enrolled full-time to receive a scholarship. Academic eligibility is evaluated prior to the beginning of each semester. The coaching staff for each sport determines scholarship recipients.

- **Book Loan Program**

Arizona residents are eligible for the book loan program. The number of books to be loaned will be determined by the Coach/ Athletic Director. Students must be academically eligible and enrolled full-time to receive book loans.
