
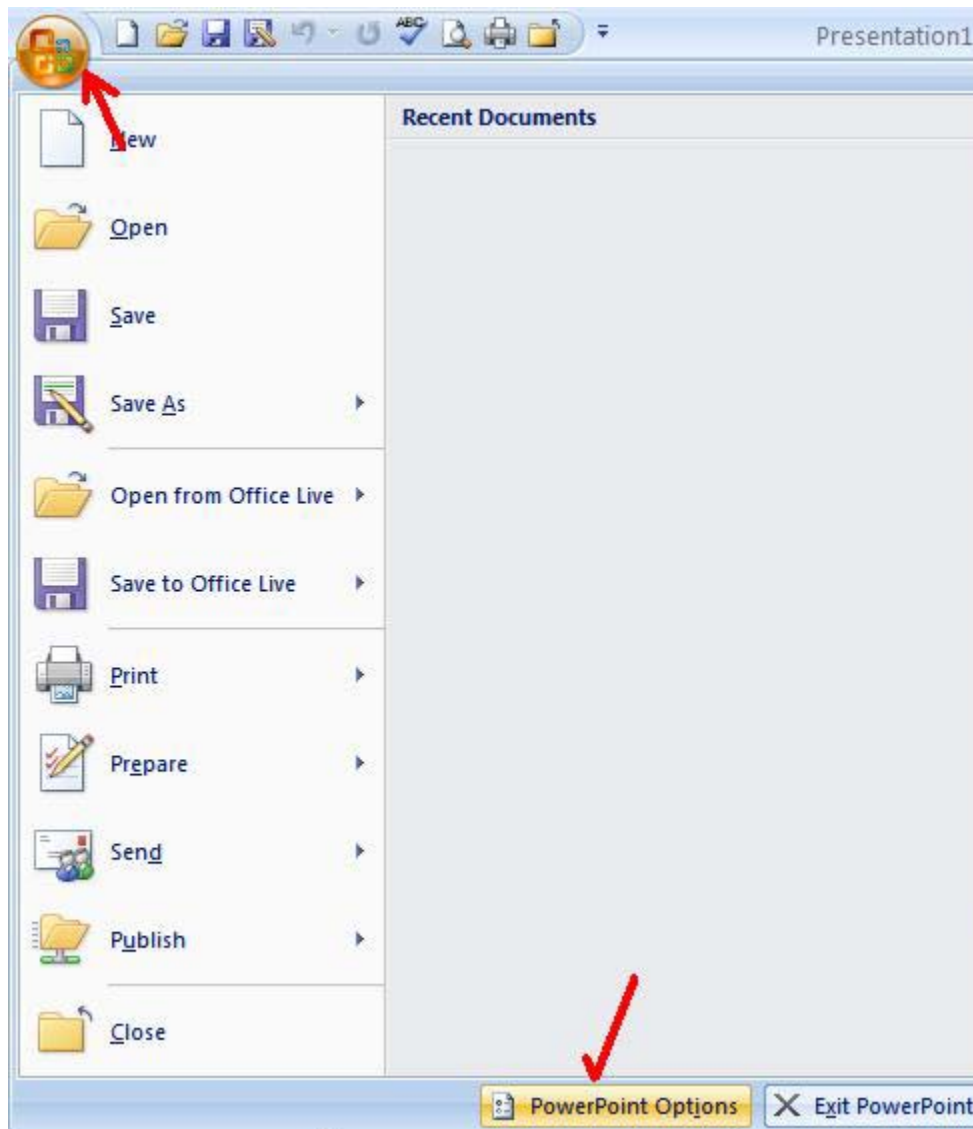
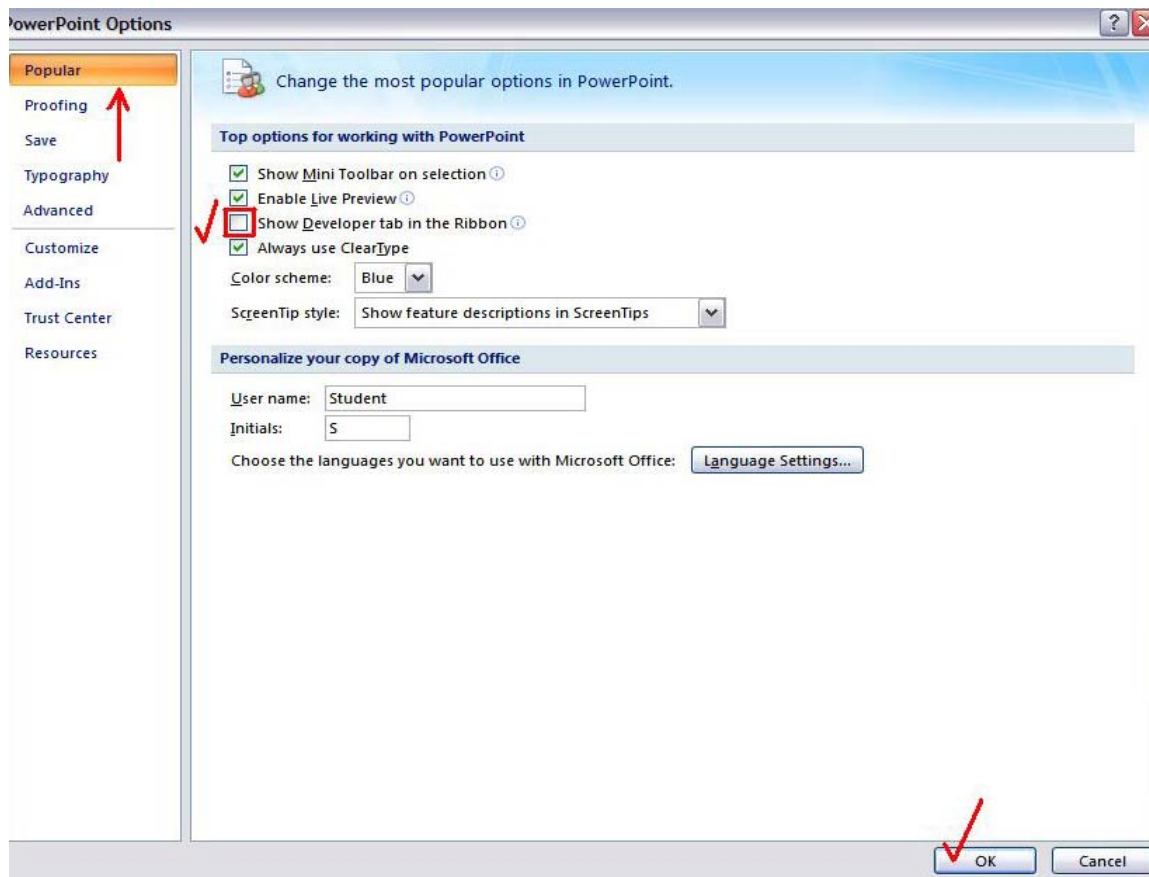


Inserting a Video from the Internet into PowerPoint

In Office 2007 PowerPoint, if the **Developer** tab is not showing in the navigational panel, click on the

Office Button  and scroll to the bottom and click on the **PowerPoint Options** tab. Within the **Popular** tab, make sure that the **Show Developer tab in the Ribbon** is checked, and then click OK.



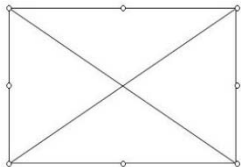


1. In the **Controls** panel, click on more controls.



2. Scroll and click on **Shockwave Flash Object**, click OK.

3. With the mouse on the slide that you want the video, draw out a box on your slide.



4. In the **Controls** panel, click on **Properties**. Widen the Properties box, by dragging on the right side.

5. Locate **Movie** field, half way down in the form. In the column next to **Movie**, insert your URL.

6. In the URL, replace all = signs and ? marks with a front slash (/). Also, remove the word “**watch**” from the URL. Close the properties window and run **PowerPoint Slide Show**.
