

When In Photoshop and wanting to create shapes all on the same layer/Path Layer do the following steps:

1. First select the *Shapes tool* (U) and select a shape you would like to use making sure you have *Shape Layers* Selected. See figure 1.

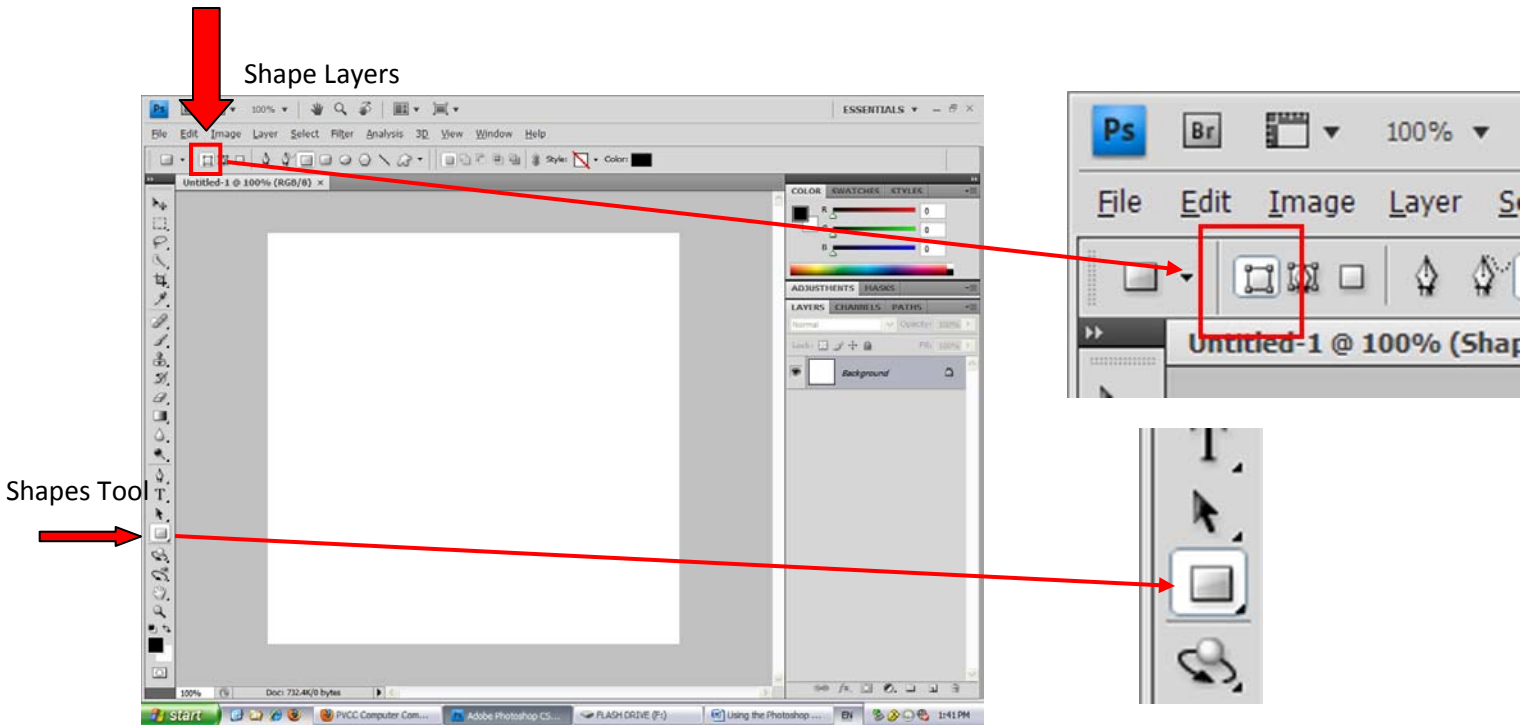
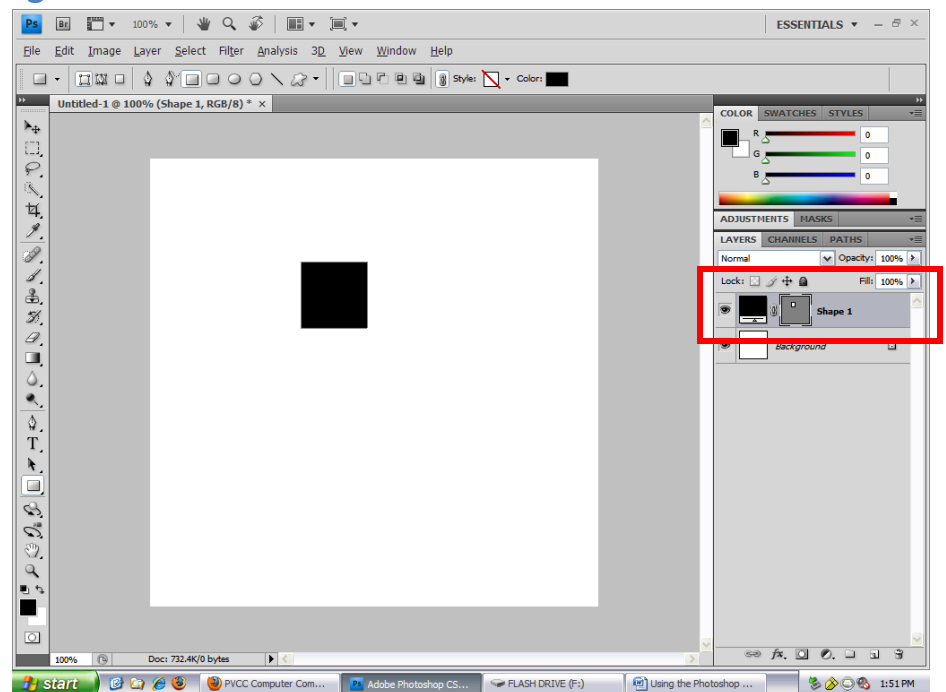

2. Next, draw your shape on the canvas by clicking the left mouse button and “dragging” out the shape. Take notice that the “Shape 1” layer is created within the “Layers” palette to the right of the window after you create your shape. See figure 2.

3. Now that you have your first shape created, it has created the layer that you will add the rest of the shapes to. With the *Shape 1* layer selected and the Shapes Tool (U) still active, press and hold the Shift key on the keyboard and begin to draw another shape just like you did in step 2. After releasing the left mouse button let go of the shift key. Notice that the new shape has been added to the first shape's layer (*Shape 1*). See figure 3.
