



MARICOPA COMMUNITY COLLEGES Maricopa Grant Assistance Program

The Maricopa Grant Assistance program is offered for Arizona high school students attending Maricopa Community Colleges.

Student recipients must demonstrate “financial need” by completing the MARICOPA GRANT APPLICATION and providing documentation of household income using the most recent year’s signed income tax return for the parent or guardians. Financial need will be indicated if household income & family size meets the eligibility requirements of the Maricopa Grant Eligibility Guidelines.

Additional Eligibility Requirements

1. Under Arizona state law, a person who is not a United States citizen or who is without lawful immigration status may not receive Maricopa Grant funds.
2. Depending on the high school student’s program, (**Dual Enrollment, ACE or Early College**), Maricopa Grant funds may be applied toward resident’s tuition, registration fees and required books and other expenditures based on each specific program. Students are responsible for charges not covered by the grant.
3. Students must complete each course within the term/semester with a grade of A, B, or C. To maintain grant and/or program eligibility, students should review additional satisfactory academic progress guidelines specific to their program.
4. Withdrawal from a course funded by the Maricopa Grant after the last date for Official Course Withdrawal will disqualify a student for any additional grant assistance while in high school.
5. A disqualified student may request reconsideration based on documented extenuating circumstances. Consideration regarding extenuating circumstances is approved or denied at the college’s discretion.
