

# Student Affairs Division Updates – February 2009

## Admissions / Records:

- ✓ Staff attended the Customer Service Training workshop
- ✓ Staff attended the President's Advance
- ✓ VA mailed out enrollment verifications to Instructors asking to verify attendance
- ✓ Clean-up rosters for 45th day have been processed

## Athletics:

- ✓ Began intercollegiate baseball program with first game opening ceremonies
- ✓ 182 student athletes generated 174.3 FTSE in the fall semester
- ✓ Five teams had fall gpa's over 3.0 (baseball 3.05, men's golf 3.349, women's tennis 3.44, women's track 3.071, women's golf 3.12)

## Counseling:

- ✓ Presented an update of iStartSmart to CSPP faculty and Math faculty nationwide during a Math conference held at PVCC
- ✓ Provided seminars to various classes regarding: study skills, avoiding procrastination, college success, and career development
- ✓ Began work on a threat assessment plan involving counselors

## Service Learning:

- ✓ 40 Students enrolled in HUM 190DEF, SLICE (Serve.Learn.Inspire.Change.Educate) traveled to San Diego during Spring Break to do service at four agencies.
- ✓ AmeriCorps Project Ayuda applying for additional funding under the Recovery Act.

## Student Development:

- ✓ Academic Advising currently up over 2600 advising sessions compared to last year (July - Feb)
- ✓ Academic Advising is developing a Transfer Center within the Academic Advising area with relevant materials for students
- ✓ ACE completed high school recruitment (Oct-Jan) and has received 72 applications for 09 - Application screening has begun.
- ✓ ACE Scholarship Fund Raiser Car Wash - Feb. 27-28, 2009
- ✓ iStartSmart training for front line personnel in preparation for Fall 2009 has begun.
- ✓ Met with Orientation Leaders to debrief the Spring 09 Orientations.
- ✓ Undergoing significant revision/redesign of Student Development and new student web pages (including a new page for Hoop of Learning) in collaboration with iStartSmart Operational Team.
- ✓ Hoop of Learning pilot is underway. Student feedback is very positive thus far. We're working on faculty and student recruitment for summer and fall.
