Scholarship Application Guidelines and Eligibility

The PVCC Leadership Scholarships are designed to foster your growth as a leader and to inspire you to develop a passion and commitment to community betterment and positive social change. You will be afforded the opportunity of interactive leadership training and personally meaningful service work. In addition, you will gain courage, confidence, and valuable insight into yourself and your community that will allow you to exceed at every level, present and future.

If you receive a leadership scholarship, you must be enrolled in the Emerging Leaders Program, (Level I or II), (LDR101 or LDR102) and you must commit to completing all aspects of the class, including attending all class meetings and completing the service-learning project in the community. The scholarship is awarded to offset the cost of enrollment in the Emerging Leaders Program. Scholarships can be awarded in full or in part based on the number of applicants. Students are notified of acceptance status prior to the start of class, but scholarship funds **are NOT awarded until after the completion of the course based on participant eligibility.**

Eligibility Criteria

- PVCC students currently enrolled with a GPA of 2.5 are eligible to apply. Students must be enrolled half-time (6 or more credits) during the semester in which they receive the scholarship.
- Completion & depth of essay
- U.S. Citizen or lawful resident (determined by collection of documentation)

Application Deadline

To receive funding all application materials must be received no later than **Monday, September 19, 2011** for Fall 2011 or **Friday, February 3, 2012** for Spring 2012. Please submit all materials to the PVCC Student Life & Leadership Office, KSC135.
