4. Enroll in LDR 201 Leadership Facilitation Course, Class #40781, 2 credits.
(Requires instructor Mike Ho's permission/signature, meets Fridays, **FALL ONLY** 8/31/2012-12/7/2012, G137.
5. One semester commitment to attending all EL events including the Orientation, Friday meetings, Reflection Celebration, and one EL retreat (either EL I or II)
6. Final interview with the Emerging Leaders planning committee or designated facilitator.
7. Participate in Puma Challenge Course facilitation throughout the term of commitment.
