



Electronic Devices Policy

During service members who have cell phones, pages, music players, and other electronic devices are to have the devices turned off and placed out of sight while earning service hours, attending training sessions, planning sessions, and other meetings. Electronic devices are a major distraction that is disruptive and keeps the owner of the device and other participants from being actively engaged.

Service sites may provide telecommunication technology equipment for AmeriCorps members to assist in the performance of their official duties. The equipment shall be used only for business purposes and AmeriCorps members must adhere to the policies provided by the sponsor agency. Improper or illegal use of e-mail or Internet resources poses a serious risk and liability to the AmeriCorps member, service site, and Project Ayuda program.
